Cost (if already registered with Netball NSW): \$25

Cost (if not registered with Netball NSW): \$50

Inclusions: The cost involved includes full registration and insurance coverage with Netball NSW. All participants will also receive the following at the end of the program: a ball; backpack; charm bracelet; face towel; and gel pens.

NB: You don't need to be registered with a club to participate and you don't need a uniform.

HOW DO I SIGN MY CHILD UP?

The program will only run if we get enough numbers, so to begin with we are only taking expressions of interest. Places in the program will be allocated on a first-in basis from this list.
